| Battle/Event | War | Significant Information |

| Alamo | Texas Revolution | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Texas vs. Mexico - “Remember the Alamo” |
| Antietam | Civil War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bloodiest battle - McClellan is fired; replaced by Grant |
| Appomattox | Civil War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Not a real battle - Robert E. Lee surrendered to Ulysses S. Grant |
| Atlanta | Civil War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Started Sherman’s March to the Sea - Union destroyed last of major railroad |
| Bulge | World War II | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Allies stopped last German offensive |
| Bunker Hill | American Revolution | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - “Don’t shoot till you see the white in their eyes” - Colonists lose but it was a morale booster |
| Fort Sumter | Civil War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - start of Civil War - Union fort in S.C |
| Gettysburg | Civil War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gettysburg Address → memorial; cemetery - Don’t let soldiers who have died be for nothing |
| Guadalcanal | World War II | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - location → islands near Australia - turns the tide of the war in the Pacific |
| Lexington-Concord | American Revolution | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - start of American Revolution - “shot heard around the world” |
| Little Big Horn | Against Native Americans (1876) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Custer’s Last Stand - Native Americans won major defeat against Americans |
| Lusitania | World War I | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - sunk by a German U-boat - United States remains neutral |

| Midway | World War II | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - location – between Japan and Hawaii - strategic locations |
| Nagasaki and Hiroshima | World War II | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Truman dropped two atomic bombs - Ended World War II |
| New Orleans | War of 1812 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - General Andrew Jackson - Saved the port |
| Okinawa | World War II | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - one of the bloodiest battles |
| Pearl Harbor | World War II | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Japan bombed Hawaii’s naval base - Brought the U.S. into WWII |
| San Juan Hill | Spanish-American War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rough Riders – led by Teddy Roosevelt |
| Saratoga | American Revolution | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - turning point of the war - France helps U.S. - General Lafayette (France) |
| USS Maine | Spanish-American War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - yellow journalism - U.S. blames Spain and helps Cuba gain independence |
| Valley Forge | American Revolution | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - not a real battle - General George Washington “saves” his troops from an awful winter |
| Vicksburg | Civil War | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Union takes control of Mississippi River - Strategic |
| Wounded Knee | Against Native Americans | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Native Americans massacred - They were practicing the Ghost Dance |
| Yorktown | American Revolution | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - last battle of the American Revolution - British Gen. Cornwallis surrendered to Gen. Washington |
| Zimmerman Note | World War I | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - message between Germany and Mexico - Germany asking Mexico to become an alliance - U.S. enters World War I |
