Mrs. Greenway was a leader in the school system from January 1, 2001, until her death on March 28, 2009. Representing Post 5 on the Board of Education, she also served as Board Chairman from January 2004 until December 2008. She devoted countless hours toward helping schools improve and students succeed.

During her five years of leadership, the board adopted its mission to accomplish high-achieving students and the vision that our system will be world-class. As chairman, she transitioned the board to consent agendas and used technology to move toward a paperless Board meeting. She ran an efficient meeting and ensured that the meetings took care of business, yet still made time to celebrate the accomplishments of Houston County school children, youth, teachers and administrators.

In addition to her service as Chairman of the Board of Education, she also served on the Georgia Professional Standards Commission. Gov. Sonny Perdue appointed her to the Commission in 2005, where she served for three years until 2008.

Her service extended beyond the field of education. A municipal court judge and private attorney, she also served on the Council of Municipal Court Judges and the Houston County Bar Association Scholarship Committee. In addition, she was on the Board of Directors for the American Cancer Society, Warner Robins Day Care and Hospice of Houston County and Chairman of the Warner Robins Downtown Development Authority.

A road-naming ceremony will be held at a later date. Veterans High School is located at 340 Piney Grove Road in Kathleen.
