- All seniors should report to the Miller – Murphy – Howard Building by 1:30 pm on May 29. We will meet inside the McGill Building. **Please personally check in with your row leader.**
- Boys: dark pants, white collared shirt, dark tie, dark socks, and shined shoes. Black shoes are recommended; no light colored shoes. Earrings, tennis shoes, blue jeans, or any other distracting attire will not be permitted. All males should be **clean shaven**.
- Girls: black shoes, dark dresses. No house slippers, tennis shoes, flip flops, combat boots or other distracting attire will be allowed.
- All gowns will be checked for unnecessary paraphernalia. Students please understand that this is a distinguished ceremony.
- The academic cap should be worn straight and level. Your class has chosen to move the tassel from one side to the other during the ceremony so all tassels should be on the right side prior to the ceremony. (Tassels are moved from the right to the left during the ceremony.)
- Students should remember that graduation is not completed until the final processional is over. All students will receive an empty cover only. After the ceremony, students should report to the line-up area to get your actual diploma.
- Those students who do not intend to march should **notify Mr. Floyd immediately.**
