Cox Channel 17 School News Moving to Channel 117 as of Oct. 18

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – On October 18, 2010, Cox's education channel located on channel 17 will move to the Digital Starter package. The move only affects those who purchase analog cable television from Cox. Digital customers will see no change.

ComSouth subscribers will not be affected; school news for ComSouth will remain on channel 10.
Important facts for Cox customers follow.

- Current Cox Advanced TV customers can continue to tune to channel 17.
- Cox digital subscribers and customers who have a TV with a built-in digital tuner will be able to view these channels without any additional equipment. The majority of televisions purchased within the past two to three years have built-in tuners.
- Cox TV Starter or Essential customers with a Digital Tuner Ready TV will need to tune to 93.1, Cox's education channel.
- Those without a TV with a built-in tuner will need a digital box.
- Cox customers who do not have a digital box or a TV with a built-in tuner may request a courtesy digital box beginning October 19, 2010, and through December 31, 2011.
- No deposit will be required for those receiving a courtesy digital box.
- To obtain a box come October 19, one may call (478) 784-8000 or visit the Cox retail store located on Watson Blvd. in Warner Robins.
