Introducing Maps 101, a Web Resource

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Houston County School System students and parents now have access to **Maps 101**, a Web-based interactive map resource. An online, cross-curricular resource, Maps 101 complements traditional materials used to teach history, social studies and geography, science, Spanish and language arts.

The Web site provides more than 7,000 preformatted maps, interactive maps, *National Geographic* videos and maps, full text articles and maps in English and Spanish, a reference atlas, educational games/quizzes, lessons with activities and more.
