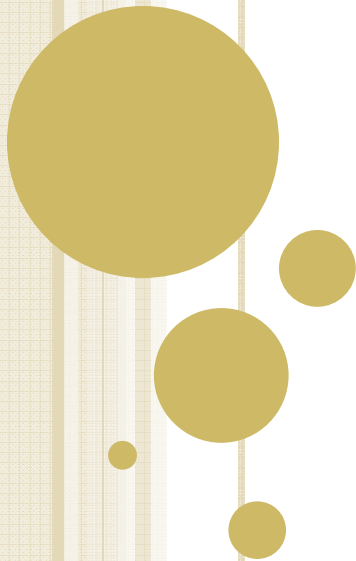

WHAT IS TITLE I?

- Title I provides financial assistance to schools with high numbers or percentages of socio-economically challenged students
- At Perry High Title I funds are used to ensure that ALL students meet challenging state academic standards

TITLE I FUNDS HAVE:

- Funded an additional English teacher to keep class sizes small.

- Purchased Smart Interactive Whiteboard for classrooms
- Purchased 32 Smart Airliner writing slates
- Purchased Senteo Classroom Response Systems for all Math and English classes
- Paid for teachers to attend Professional Development conferences.
