BMS Student Honored at National FFA Agriscience Fair



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Bonaire Middle School student Camden Wing competed in the National FFA Agriscience Fair held Oct. 20 - 23, 2010, in Indianapolis, Ind. Camden was awarded a silver pin in honor of her project titled “Fly Ash Spill.”

Camden’s success at the state level qualified her to compete at national. All 580 participants were honored with a gold, silver or bronze pin which was presented during an Agriscience Awards program held at the National FFA Convention.

The agriscience fair program was sponsored by Cargill and Syngenta as a special project of the National FFA Foundation. Cash awards were given to the top three winners in each category and division.
