The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. Members present: Dr. Pryby, Rachel Miller, Marya Shone, Adrienne Ray

Dr. Pryby gave us some dates for our upcoming events. Three clubs responded to participate in the Fall Festival. They are the Spanish Club, Chorus, and Pep Club. However, we need more participation for the Festival to be successful.

It is important that we find out what we can do for our students to make their years at HOCO enjoyable. STPO will attend some club meetings to see where we can be of service, as well as obtain suggestions and ideas from the students. We also hope to recruit some of them to take part in our organization.

The Community Service Projects for the year so far which include a commitment to FCCLA are as follows:

- ✚ **Coat Drive** – STPO join forces with Middle Georgia Technical College to collect coats for the needy.
- ✚ **Senior Barbeque** – The date has not been set.
- ✚ **Shoebboxes for Soldier** – STPO will help FCCLA collect items for the soldiers who will not be home for Christmas (for example: individual package snack items, cards, crossword puzzles, magazines, pens, notepads, toiletries, iTunes cards,

cereal, sugar packets, Tylenol, tissue, sunscreen, beef jerky, peanuts, envelopes, etc.). Do not donate any items that will melt or break. Shoe boxes are needed as well. The Shoe Carnival is saving extra boxes for this event. You can pick some up from there. **You can turn your items to any STPO member or to rooms 708 or 602 before November 2.**

✚ **Project Linus** – FCCLA is also making and donating blankets to the sick children in Houston Medical Center. STPO will be helping FCCLA reach their goal of 100 blankets to be delivered **December 3**. You can help by donating blankets, by donating fleece (1 ½ - 2 yards), or by donating money (each blanket cost about \$20). ✚ **Bear Brawl** – STPO will help provide refreshment to the VIPs during this basketball tournament. The date of the Brawl is December 18, 20, & 21.
