HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Warner Robins High School senior Jeremy Sulik will be recognized as the Academic All Star Athlete this week, April 4 - 10, 2011. Spots are airing on Georgia Public Broadcast Television just before the 8:00 p.m. programming Monday through Sunday and just before the 8:30 p.m. programming on Friday. Georgia high school principals were asked to nominate one male and one female senior meeting the following criteria: lettered in one or more varsity sports; GPA of 3.7 or higher; one Advanced Placement class where the student received a score of 3 or better; and SAT combined score (reading, math and writing) of 1880 or better or ACT score of 28 or better out of a possible 36.

An objective panel selected 72 winners for the 2010-2011 School Year. Winners will receive a plaque, with an additional plaque for their high school. Two Academic All-Star Athletes are recognized on-air each week on GPB Television and GPB.
