**Northside High Selected as 2011 Learning Resources Site**

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Northside High School has been selected as a 2011 Learning Resources Evaluation Site by the Georgia Department of Education. This offers the public an opportunity to review textbooks and other learning resources for Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE). Any interested persons are invited to stop by the school between July 6 and 14, 2011, Monday through Thursday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Learning resources for review and evaluation are in the cafeteria. These CTAE resources may be used in the classroom over the coming years.

Northside High is one of 13 sites around the state with one in each of Georgia's Congressional Districts. Educators and others are encouraged to review and comment on materials submitted by publishers for consideration. Each year, the state reviews learning resources that relate to a particular subject or group of subjects in order to create a recommended list.

Learning resources that meet standards as set by the state are recommended. Each local system determines which learning resources best meet the system's particular instructional needs. School systems rely on the recommended list as their primary source of information about available learning resources and turn to it first when beginning their local recommendation process. After the summer review, the Learning Resources Advisory Committee will meet late July to compile a recommended list of learning resources for approval by the State Board of Education.
