- The meeting schedule was set for the remainder of the 2011-2012 school year:

All meetings take place in Room 16.
- Reviewed AYP data report for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. The achievement gaps are almost gone. If NCLB is eliminated AYP %'s will go away.
- Review of Annual Measurable Objective Data: Reading-95.7% and Math-89%. Discussed where we are and where we need to be. After final AYP reports are approved, all data will be updated.

- Discussed SPLOST, closing of Perry Primary School. All Perry schools will be Pre-K through 5 and everyone in Perry will be rezoned. The new school will be built on Langston Road. If the SPLOST is approved it is anticipated that 2012-2013 will be the last year that MSES will be a grade 2-5 school. If the SPLOST is not renewed, the penny goes into the General Fund for Houston County, it does not go away.
- Class sizes: 2<sup>nd</sup> grade-6 classes with 19 students per class on average  
3<sup>rd</sup> grade-5 classes with 18 students per class on average  
4<sup>th</sup> grade-4 classes with 25 students per class on average  
5<sup>th</sup> grade-5 classes with 22 students per class on average
