HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Feagin Mill Middle School Assistant Principal Jim Langley has been named the Georgia Outstanding Assistant Principal for District 11. The Georgia Association of Middle School Principals (GAMSP) presents this award. Langley will be honored Nov. 5, 2011, at the GAMSP Fall Conference Awards Luncheon at St. Simons Island.

Langley is a product of the Houston County School System. After graduating from Northside High, he attended the University of Georgia, earning a Bachelor of Music Education degree. He began his teaching career at Harlem High and Grovetown Elementary in 1985. He returned to Northside High as band director in 1987, teaching at Northside until 1992 when he joined the faculty and staff at Bert Rumble Middle. When Feagin Mill Middle opened in 1996, Langley was selected to establish the band program. At that time, he began to serve in several leadership positions within the school and through the Georgia Music Educators Association, sparking an interest in education administration. In April of 2004, Langley was chosen as an assistant principal at Northside Middle School. In 2007, he was appointed Assistant Principal of Instruction for Feagin Mill Middle.

Feagin Mill Middle Principal Dr. Jesse Davis said, “The people who work in the Houston County School System have always been our greatest resources. Jim Langley is example number one of this reality. Mr. Langley leads each day by example and embodies all those qualities that allow someone to be a great leader.
