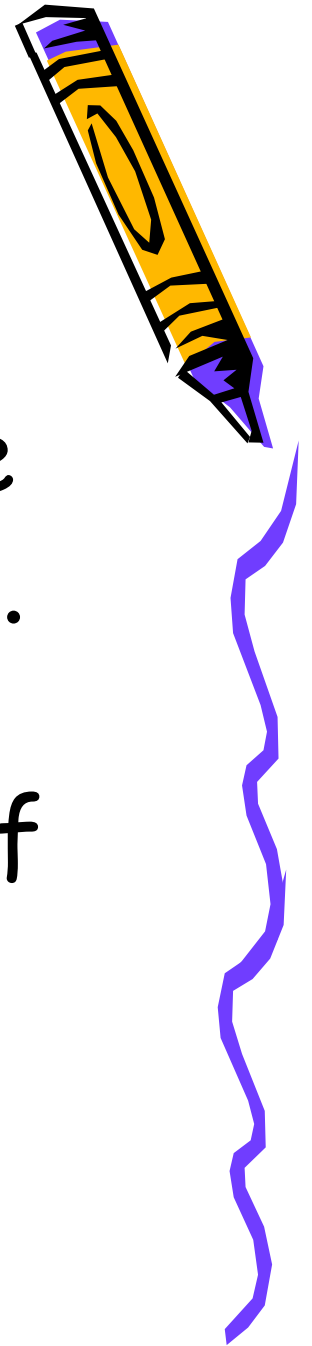
Eagle Springs - School-wide Title 1 Program

- Supports our mission to encourage, guide, and support all students to reach their highest potential.



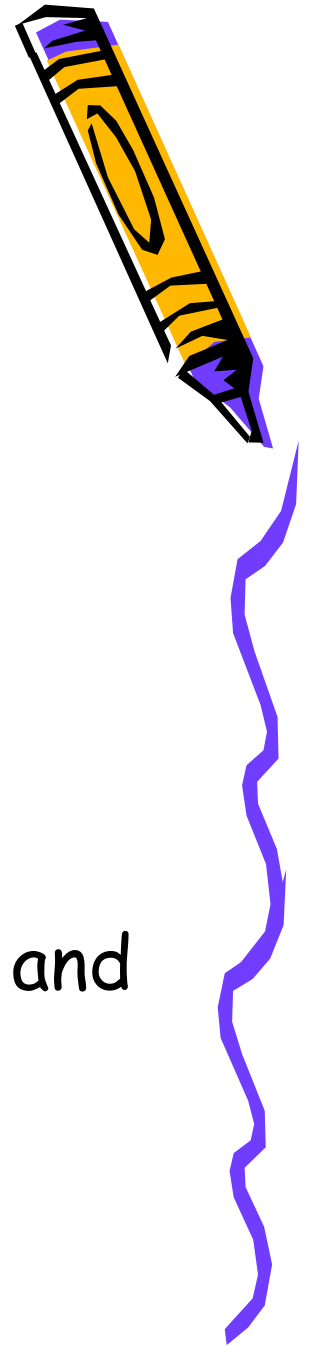
High Expectations

- ES has made AYP (adequate yearly progress) every year. This status is based on our CRCT results in the areas of reading, ELA, and math in 3rd - 5th grade.



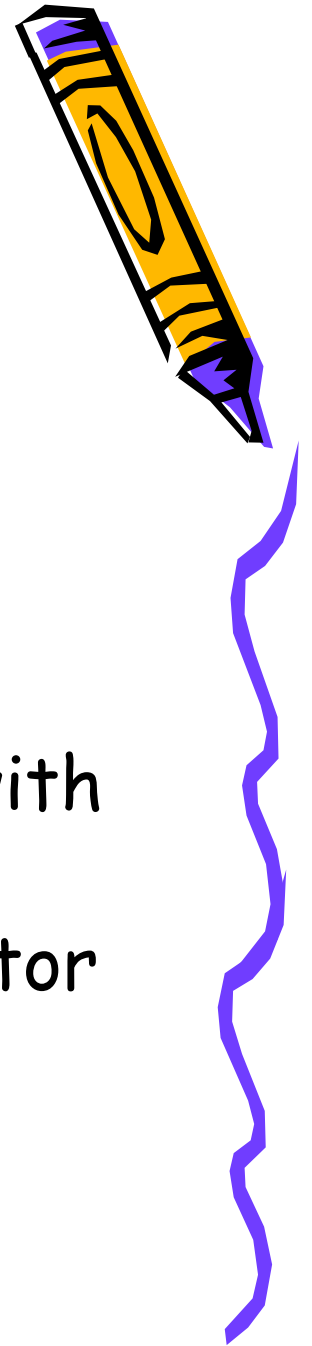
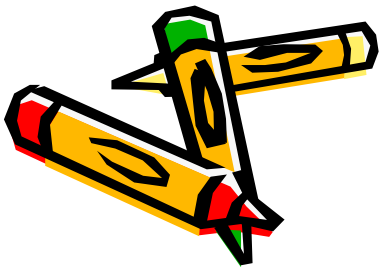

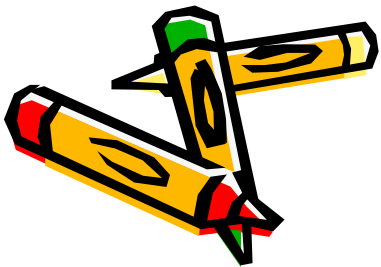


Parent Involvement

- Mrs. Kelly Sitrin will serve our school as the Parent Involvement Coordinator.

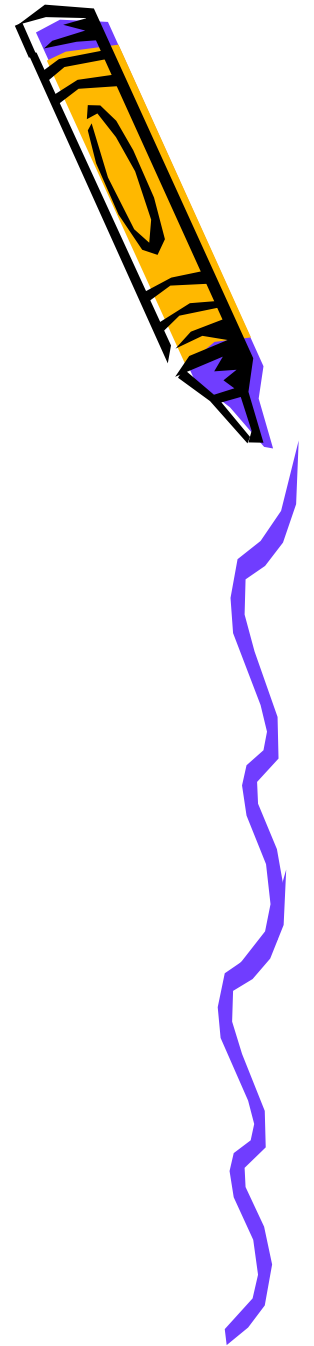

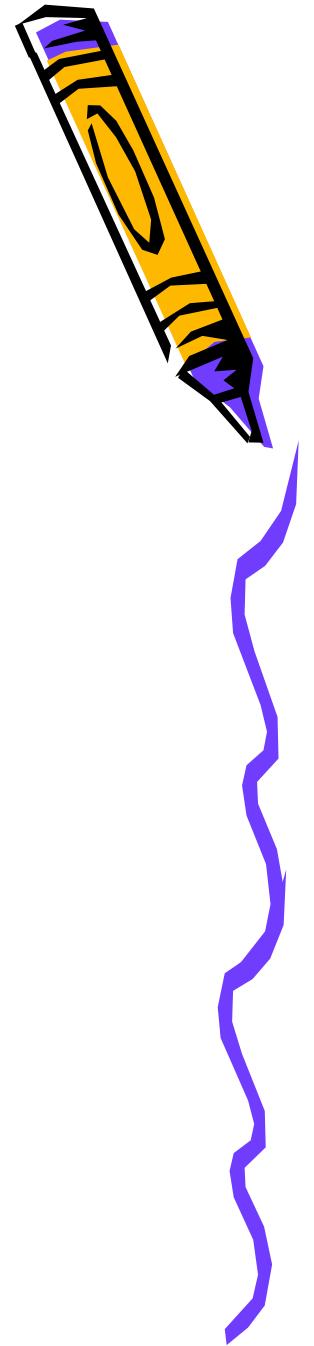
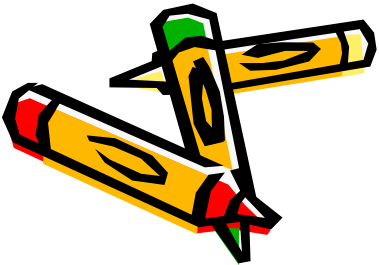

- Training dates are held monthly and can be found in our Monthly Parent Newsletter that goes home the first of each month or contact Mrs. Sitrin.



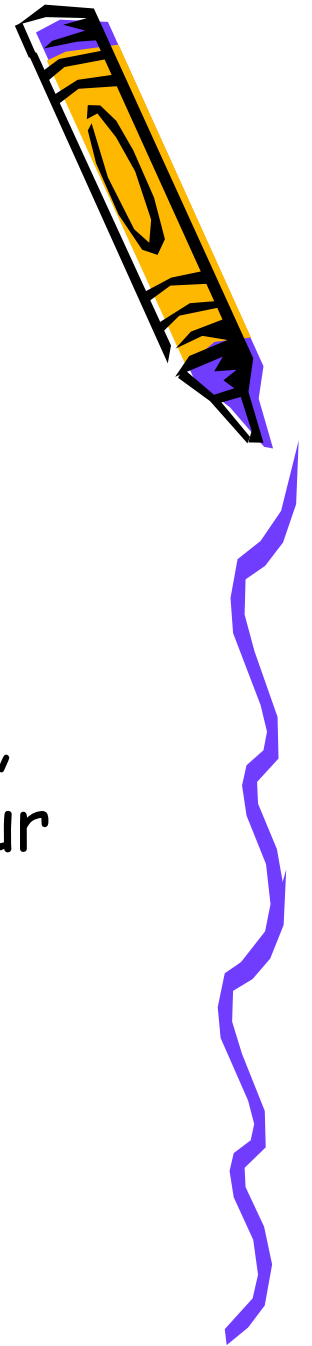
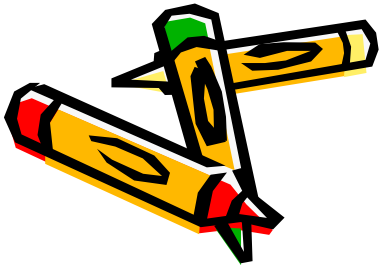

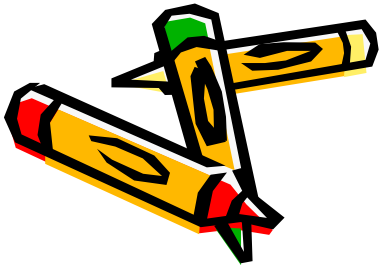
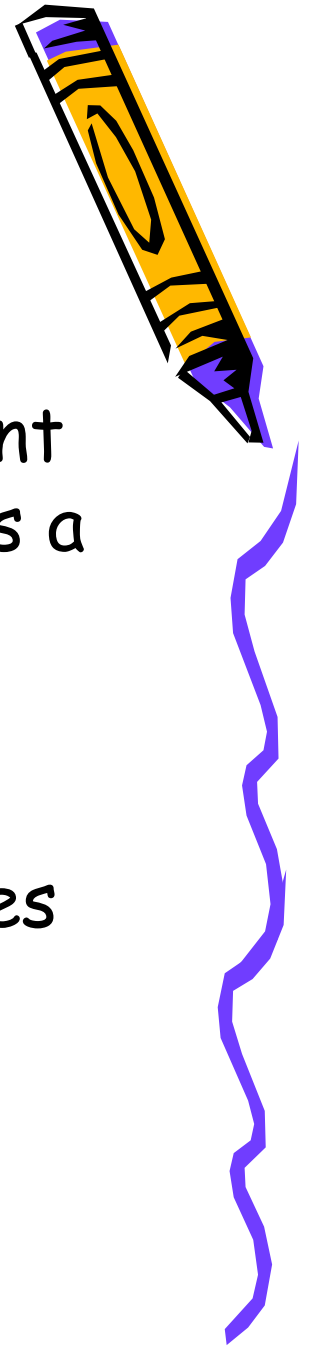
- We would love to have your input!

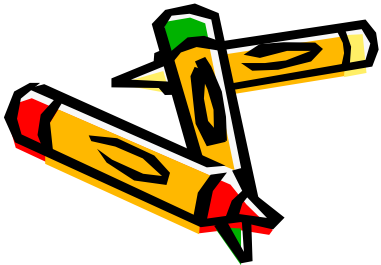

- School Council Meetings are held 4 times to discuss our school improvement plan, Title 1 plans, budget, etc.

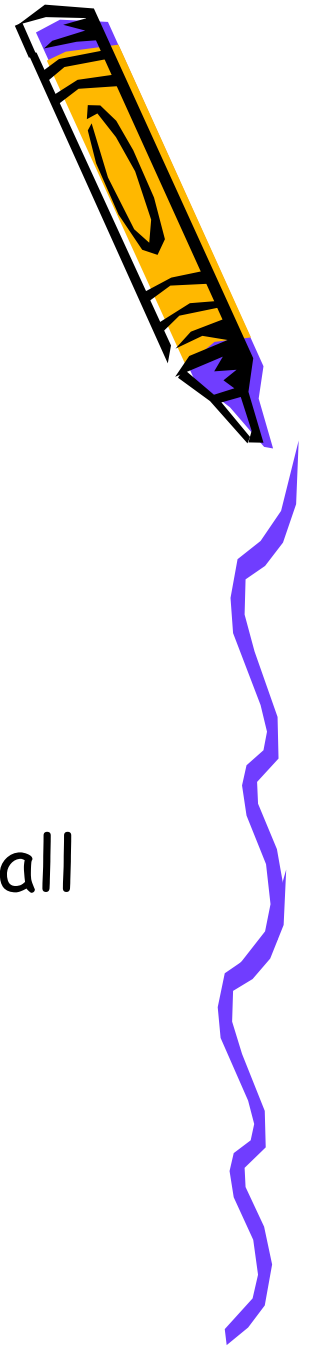
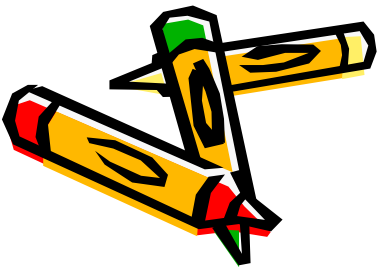

- If you have any questions feel free to speak to one of our administrators.

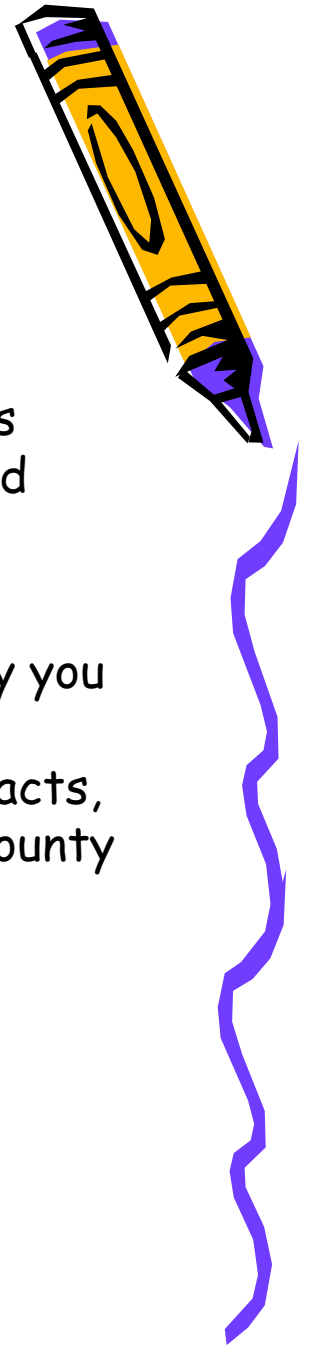
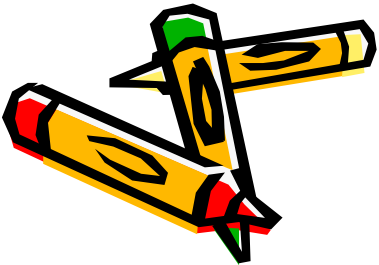


Attendance

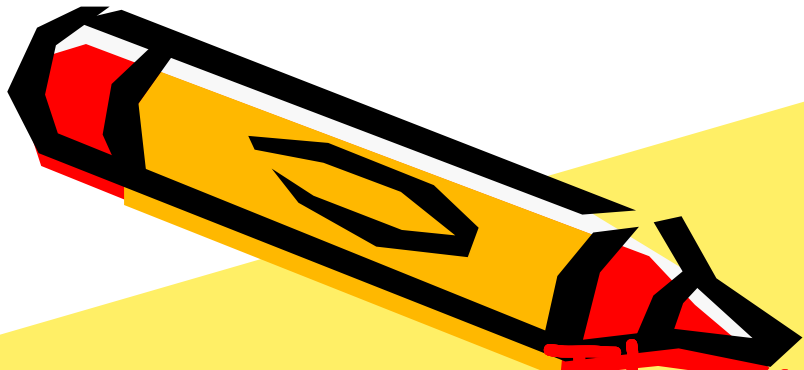
Please try to schedule appointments so that students miss a minimum amount of instructional time.
