HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Northside Middle School will rededicate a Freedom Shrine Dec. 15, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. The Freedom Shrine is a program of the Exchange Club. It has mounted replicas of documents which formed the foundation of the United States such as the: Mayflower Compact, Declaration of Independence, Constitution and Armistice document which signaled the end of World War II. The Perry Exchange Club is providing replacement documents for Northside Middle's Freedom Shrine.

The Exchange's goal is to place a Freedom Shrine in every middle and high school in the nation. They have also been installed in universities, libraries, state capitols and other public venues.
