The school's Thanksgiving dinner will be on Nov. 17th - we ask that parents/grandparents **do not eat** with their children that day because there is no way for us to accommodate a large crowd of visitors. Please feel free to eat on any other day of the week and let other family members who eat with your child know of this change. We want to thank you up front for your cooperation.

Need Your Help!

We want to remind parents that the front drive is not to be used for drop offs in the morning. This is for buses and daycare vans only. We have also had cars from time to time drive to the end of the hallways to drop kids off. This is not allowed and we do not want cars on the playground area as we have walkers and some student especially on the 300 hallway going to our Focus classrooms in the mornings. They are not expecting cars to be back there and this poses a safety issue.

We also ask that you do not park in the front drive unless you are just coming into pick up or sign out a student. We have busses and delivery trucks that need to use this area throughout the day and if a parent is parked there for an extended time – it could cause us to have some traffic problems and we prefer to not have to do an all call to have a car move - especially during instructional time.

Students need to be in their classrooms by 8:30. If they are coming in the building after the bell rings they will be counted tardy. If you hear the announcements or notice that Coach James is no longer out on the car ramp - you should park and bring your child in to sign in tardy. Please try to get to the school a few minutes earlier so your child can make it to class on time. Thank you for your help and cooperation with this matter.
