~ 700 Students to Compete in Regional Science & Engineering Fair *Students from Two Counties Submitting Projects*

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA - The Houston Regional Science and Engineering Fair will be held Feb. 1 – 3, 2012, at the Robins Air Force Base Museum of Aviation in the Century of Flight Hangar. An awards ceremony will be held Friday, Feb. 3, at 6:30 p.m. More than 700 middle and high school students from Houston County and Peach County public and private schools will compete.

The fair is open to the public from 10:00 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 3. Students will setup their display boards on Tuesday, Jan. 31, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Judges will interview participants on Wednesday, Feb. 1.

Three individual grand prizes will be awarded - one for the junior division and two for the senior division. One team grand prize will also be awarded to a senior team. Thirty-eight students will be honored as first-place qualifiers. Winners will compete at the State Science Fair in Athens, Ga. at the University of Ga., March 30 - 31, 2012. The International Fair will be held May 14 – 18, 2012, in Pittsburgh.
