

Houston County High School Dance Dress Code and Code of Conduct

Senior Ball

Senior Ball is a formal and special night enjoyed by Houston County High School students since the first years of the school's existence. We hope to maintain the integrity and formality of this night by implementing this simple dress code.

Gentlemen: Formal attire is required and may be classified as a tuxedo or dress suit including a tie, bow tie, turtle neck, polo, etc. Slacks, dress pants, kakis, are considered appropriate for such an occasion as jeans or shorts are not permitted. Shirts must be worn at all times and pants must be worn at the natural waist.

Ladies: Dresses may be strapless or include spaghetti straps. Bare, open, or see through backs/ midriffs above the waist are permissible. Dresses shorter than or with slits rising above mid-thigh are not permitted nor are those that improperly expose the chest area.

Houston County's Code of Conduct will be enforced. For example, students who have been suspended or are in ISS may not attend. Students attending Crossroads or expelled from Crossroads may not attend. Students will need their tickets or invitations and student identification to enter the dance. There will be no passes out. Once you leave the dance, you will not be permitted to return. Students are expected to dance and behave in a manner befitting a formal, school sponsored event.
