What is Title I?

Title I provides financial assistance to schools with high numbers or high percentages of socio-economically challenged children.

Why is PHS a Title I school?

To help ensure that all students meet challenging state academic standards.

Title I Requirements

- Parent involvement.
- Maintaining an inventory.
- Supplementing, not supplanting instruction.
- Providing credentials for schoolwide staff.
- Hold an annual meeting for parents.

How did we become a Schoolwide Title I school?

- The school's poverty level exceeded 40%.
- The district decided it would be in our students' best interest for us to become a Schoolwide Title I school.

How did we become a Schoolwide Title I school?

- A Schoolwide plan was developed over a one-year period
- The plan was created by a diverse group of stakeholders
 - Teachers
 - Principals
 - pupil services personnel
 - parents and community members.

Title I funds have ...

- Purchased all but 3 of the Smart Interactive Whiteboards at PHS.
- Purchased 32 Smart Airliner writing slates
- Purchased Senteo Classroom Response Systems for all Math and English Teachers.

Title I funds have ...

- Purchased common calculators to improve Math GHS GT Test scores.
- Paid to have participants attend the International Model Schools Conference in June 2008.

Title I funds have ...

- Funded 1.5 teaching positions that support English and Math Instruction at PHS.
