Kindergarten Supply List

Needed Supplies:

- 4 boxes of 16 count Crayola crayons (no markers or colored pencils please)
- 1 pack of #2 pencils (no ink pens please)
- 6 small glue sticks
- 2 glue bottles
- book bag (rolling book bags are not allowed at QRE)
- 1 box of Kleenex tissues

Wish List:

In addition to these items various others used during the year include: paper plates (not styrofoam- small and large), paper towels, hand sanitizer, hand soap, baby wipes, wobbly eyes of different sizes, copy paper, white paper lunch bags, and “one-zip” type Ziploc bags (all sizes). Any donation of these items would be greatly appreciated. You may also donate extras of the above “needed supplies”, such as pencils or glue sticks. If your child is in Mrs. McDermott’s, Mrs. Williams’, and Mrs. Brewer’s, classes a pencil box (approximately 5” x 9”) would be appreciated.

*The kindergarten students rest for the first nine weeks of school. Your child needs something on which to rest.....mat, blanket, towel, etc. (no sleeping bags please).

First Grade Supply List

- Expo Markers (Assorted Colors)
- Colored pencils
- Pencil box
- 3 pocket folders with prongs (1 red, 1 blue, 1 green)
- White paper lunch bags

Wish List:

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- Zip Lock Bags (sandwich, quart, or gallon)
- Laser Printer Labels (1” x 2 5/8” or larger)
- Hand Sanitizer
- Liquid soap
- Highlighters
